For business owners, there is a lot you can do on South Carolina Business One Stop. SCBOS offers you a business-to-government portal which allows you to apply and pay for licenses, registrations, permits and other official filings. Simply type www.scbos.com into your web browser.

As a quick overview, here are some of the things you can do on SCBOS:

- Reserve/Register/Adopt Names with the Secretary of State
- Establish Business Entity with Secretary of State
- Submit filings to inform Secretary of State about changes to your business
- Register as an employer with the SC Department of Employment and Workforce
- Obtain a Sales Tax Registration
- Register for Corporate Taxes
- Apply for or Renew an Alcohol Beverage License
- Obtain DHEC Environmental Permits
- Department of Consumer Affairs Consumer Credit Grantor filings
- Department of Plant Industry permits (general fertilizer, liming permits, etc.)
